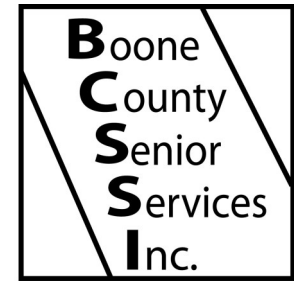

Personal Service Program

Personal Service—Personal Service provides specialized in-home care by a certified personal care staff member.

- Care Plan Assessment

- Attendant Care

Homemaker—Homemaker service provides quality services by trained staff members. Homemaker schedules allow for one or two hours of service weekly or biweekly at a routine time and day.

- Light Housekeeping
- Changing of Bed Linens
- Dusting

- Limited Grocery Shopping

Respite—Respite care relieves a caretaker caring for a loved one. Routine schedules allow 2-3 hours per day, 1 to 2 times per week.

Guardianship—Duties of this court-ordered program are to oversee the welfare and safety of the person under Guardianship.

Transportation

Call to Schedule

Boone County Senior Services, Inc. and Boone Area Transit System (BATS) provides transportation service to Boone County residents over the age of 60, Medicaid clients for medical appointments and public transportation for those under the age of 60.

The demand-response program (including wheelchair transport) is available **5 days** a week between the hours of **7:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.** The service is available for destinations in Boone County and surrounding counties.

- **Senior (Over 60)**
Transportation for appointments, shopping, activities and more in Boone and surrounding counties.
- **Medicaid**—Transportation to medical appointments in Boone and surrounding counties.
- **Public (Under 60)**
Transportation anywhere in Boone and surrounding counties.

Transportation service is scheduled as availability permits; medical needs have first priority. Call for fee schedule.

Reservations must be made in advance by calling the agency. Next day reservations must be made by 1 p.m. and all reservations must be made by 4 p.m.
