
As we enter into the second year of our current 5-year Strategic Plan (2024-28), there are a couple of areas that I would like to highlight:

## **Giant Buckeye Cookie**

From: Taste of Home

1 regular size chocolate cake mix 2 eggs

1/2 c. canola oil

1 c. semisweet chocolate chips

1 c. creamy peanut butter

1/2 c. confectioner's sugar Optional Toppings: hot fudge, whipped cream, ice cream, melted creamy peanut butter

Preheat oven to 350°. Mix cake mix, eggs, and oil until blended. Press half of the dough into a 10 inch cast iron or oven proof skillet. Combine peanut butter and confectioner's sugar and spread over dough in skillet. Press remaining dough into a 10 inch circle between two sheets of parchment paper and place on top of the filling. Bake 20-25 minutes, until a toothpick inserted in the middle comes out with moist crumbs. Serve warm with desired toppings.
